Cell Pathway	Cytoplasm . Nucleus . Cytoplasm, cytoskeleton, microtubule organizing center, centrosome . Actively transported to the centrosome and accumulated in the pericentriolar material (PCM) during G1 to M phase via a microtubule-dependent mechanism. During late telophase and cytokinesis, translocates from the centrosome to the midbody. .
Tissue Specificity	Widely expressed with higher expression levels in liver.
Function	function:Transcriptional activator which binds the cAMP response element (CRE) (consensus: 5'-GTGACGT[AC][AG]-3'), a sequence present in many viral and cellular promoters and blocks the differentiation of neuroprogenitor cells into neurons. Its transcriptional activity is enhanced by CCND3 and slightly inhibited by CDK4.,similarity:Belongs to the bZIP family.,similarity:Contains 1 bZIP

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domain.,subunit: Binds DNA as a dimer. Interacts with PTP4A1/PRL-1 (By similarity). Interacts with CCND3, but not with CCND1 or CCND2.,

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




