<b>Cell Pathway</b>	Nucleus . Cytoplasm, cytosol .
<b>Tissue Specificity</b>	Highly expressed in embryonic stem cells (ESCs). Expression decreases as ESCs differentiate.
<b>Function</b>	function:Acts as a regulatory subunit of the 26S proteasome which is involved in the ATP-dependent degradation of ubiquitinated proteins.,similarity:Belongs to the proteasome subunit S9 family.,similarity:Contains 1 PCI domain.,subunit:Component of the PA700 complex.,
<b>Background</b>	The 26S proteasome is a multicatalytic proteinase complex with a highly ordered structure composed of 2 complexes, a 20S core and a 19S regulator. The 20S core is composed of 4 rings of 28 non-identical subunits; 2 rings are composed of 7 alpha subunits and 2 rings are composed of 7 beta subunits. The 19S regulator

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is composed of a base, which contains 6 ATPase subunits and 2 non-ATPase subunits, and a lid, which contains up to 10 non-ATPase subunits. Proteasomes are distributed throughout eukaryotic cells at a high concentration and cleave peptides in an ATP/ubiquitin-dependent process in a non-lysosomal pathway. This gene encodes a member of the proteasome subunit S9 family that functions as a non-ATPase subunit of the 19S regulator and is phosphorylated by AMP-activated protein kinase. Alternatively spliced transcript variants have been observed for this gene. [provided by RefSeq,








Western Blot analysis of various cells using PSMD11 Polyclonal Antibody
