Cell Pathway	[Isoform 3]: Cytoplasm, cytosol . Mitochondrion membrane ; Peripheral membrane protein. Early endosome membrane ; Peripheral membrane protein. Translocates to membrane vesicles in a calcium-dependent fashion. . ; [Isoform 5]: Cytoplasm, cytosol .
Tissue Specificity	Widely expressed. Expressed at higher level in brain, heart, liver, cerebellum and pancreas.
Function	catalytic activity:Phosphatidylcholine + H(2)O = 1-acylglycerophosphocholine + a carboxylate.,caution:Most tissues also express read-through transcripts from this gene into the upstream gene (Jmjd7), some of which may encode fusion proteins.,caution:This sequence was first thought to be an alternatively spliced isoform of Pla2g4b. It is derived from Jmjd7 which is located upstream of Pla2g4b. Most tissues also express read-through transcripts from Jmjd7 into the downstream Pla2g4b gene, some of which may encode fusion proteins combining the N-terminus of this protein with PLA2G4B protein.,domain:The N-terminal C2 domain associates with lipid membranes and mediates its regulation by

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presenting the active site to its substrate in response to elevations of cytosolic Ca(2+).,enzyme regulation:Stimulated by cytosolic Ca(2+).,function:Calcium-dependent phospholipase A2 that selectively hydroly

Background

This locus represents naturally-occurring readthrough transcription between the neighboring jumonji domain containing 7 (JMJD7) and phospholipase A2, group IVB (cytosolic) (PLA2G4B) genes. Readthrough transcripts encode fusion proteins that share amino acid sequence with each individual gene product, including a partial JmjC domain and downstream C2 and phospholipase A2 domains. Alternatively spliced transcript variants have been observed. [provided by RefSeq, Oct 2013],
