Function	catalytic activity:Similar to cathepsin L, but with much less activity on Z-Phe-Arg- -NHMe, and more activity on the Z-Val-Val-Arg- -Xaa compound.,function:Thiol protease. Key protease responsible for the removal of the invariant chain from MHC class II molecules. The bond-specificity of this proteinase is in part similar to the specificities of cathepsin L and cathepsin N.,similarity:Belongs to the peptidase C1 family.,subunit:Monomer.,
Background	The protein encoded by this gene, a member of the peptidase C1 family, is a lysosomal cysteine proteinase that may participate in the degradation of antigenic proteins to peptides for presentation on MHC class II molecules. The encoded protein can function as an elastase over a broad pH range in alveolar macrophages. Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding distinct isoforms

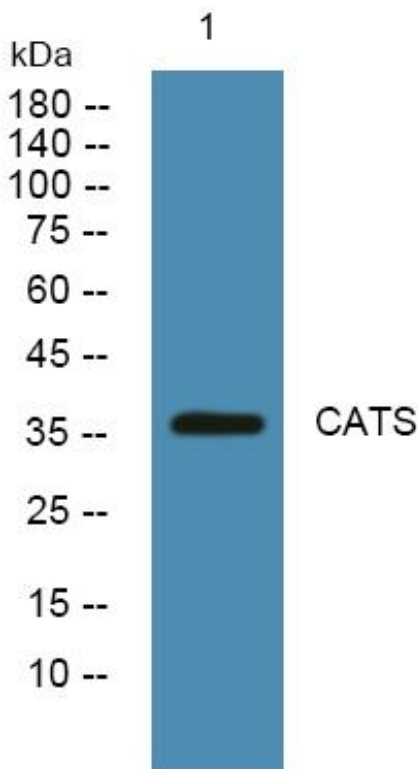
