In complex with EPS8 inhibits internalization of EGFR.,PTM:Phosphorylated upon DNA damage, probably by ATM or ATR.,similarity:Contains 1 Rab-GAP TBC domain.,subunit:Interacts with EPS8.,tissue specificity:Widely expressed.,

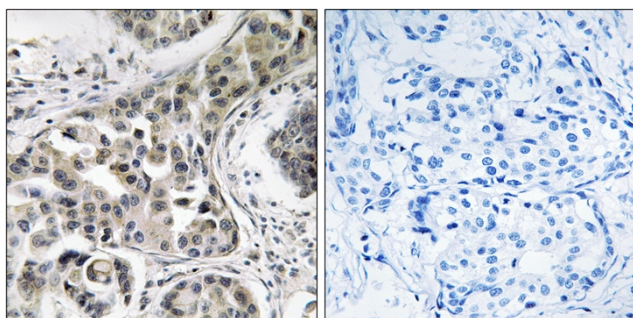
