Probably is operated by a phosphatidylinositol second messenger system activated by receptor tyrosine kinases or G-protein coupled receptors. Activated by diacylglycerol (DAG) (By similarity). May also be activated by intracellular calcium store depletion.,similarity:Belongs to the transient receptor family. STrpC subfamily.,similarity:Contains 4 ANK repeats.,subunit:Interacts with MX1 and RNF24.,
