Cell Pathway	Cell membrane ; Single-pass type II membrane protein .; [Isoform 2]: Endoplasmic reticulum .; [Isoform 4]: Endoplasmic reticulum .
Tissue Specificity	Detected in peripheral blood leukocytes, osteoblasts, lymph node, thymus and spleen. Isoform 1, isoform 2 and isoform 4 are expressed in T- and B-lymphocytes, and at lower levels in NK cells. They are also expressed in B-cell lines and LPS-matured monocyte-derived dendritic cells.
Function	function:Receptor for KLRB1 that protects target cells against natural killer cell-mediated lysis. Inhibits osteoclast formation. Inhibits bone resorption. Modulates the release of interferon-gamma. Binds high molecular weight sulfated glycosaminoglycans.,induction:Up-regulated by IL-1alpha and prostaglandin E2 in cultured osteogenic sarcoma cells.,online information:LLT1,similarity:Contains 1 C-type lectin domain.,tissue specificity:Detected in peripheral blood leukocytes, osteoblasts, lymph node, thymus and spleen.,

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**Background**

This gene encodes a member of the natural killer cell receptor C-type lectin family. The encoded protein inhibits osteoclast formation and contains a transmembrane domain near the N-terminus as well as the C-type lectin-like extracellular domain. Several alternatively spliced transcript variants have been identified for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Oct 2010],

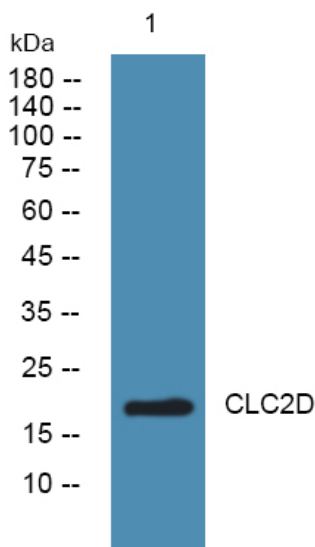
