Function	function:May play a role in compensating for the inactivated X-linked gene during spermatogenesis.,miscellaneous:This gene has no introns in its coding regions, and therefore was most likely produced by retrotransposition of the original X-linked gene during evolution.,similarity:Belongs to the ribosomal protein L10e family.,tissue specificity:Testis specific.,
Background	This gene encodes a protein sharing sequence similarity with ribosomal protein L10. It is not currently known whether the encoded protein is a functional ribosomal protein or whether it has evolved a function that is independent of the ribosome. This gene is intronless. 
